STAFFING:

In September we welcome back Mrs Hepworth from her maternity leave. Mrs Hepworth will resume her role as Class Teacher, Assistant Headteacher and SENDco.

As we approach the next academic year, I want to take a moment to acknowledge some upcoming changes within our school community. I truly appreciate the dedication and commitment of all our staff and thank them for the contributions they make to St Mary's. This includes our teachers and support staff, whose hard work and care make a meaningful difference each and every day, ensuring a positive environment for our pupils to learn and grow.

One of these changes is welcoming back Mrs Hepworth from her maternity leave. She will resume her roles as Class Teacher, Assistant Headteacher, and SENDco, and we are pleased to have her back as part of our team

Many of you will be aware that Mr Chapman has been absent for some time following a minor accident. We remain hopeful that he will return shortly after the May half-term holiday. As planned, Mr Chapman will retire at the end of the summer term after 14 years of service to St Mary's School. He has been a valued member of our school community, and we appreciate his dedication and contributions over the years. While he will be missed, we wish him well as he begins his retirement.

Additionally, Mrs Booth, Class Teacher and RE Lead, will be stepping away from her teaching position after 13 years of dedicated service. While she has gradually reduced her working days, we are grateful that she will still be a familiar face in the school, taking on supply cover work. Mrs Booth has been a hardworking and passionate member of our teaching staff, and we sincerely thank her for her contributions, wishing her every success in this next chapter.

With these changes, Governors are currently in the process of recruiting a new site manager, and we are delighted to welcome Mrs Bell to our teaching team. We look forward to the new ideas and enthusiasm she will bring to our school community.

ASSESSMENTS AND REPORTS:

END OF YEAR ASSESSMENTS IN SCHOOL:

Year 6 pupils have now completed their SAT's. We are so very proud of all of our Year 6 pupils who worked extremely hard and tried their very best. Well done Year 6 !

Pupils in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 children have also completed most of their Summer Assessments.

YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING:

Year 1 (and a small number of Year 2 pupils) will complete the statutory phonic screening check. The phonics screening is a short, light-touch assessment to confirm whether individual pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It comprises of a list of 40 words and non-words; which pupils will read one-to-one with their class teacher. Schools are required to administer the check during the week of the 9th June. Outcomes of the screening will be reported to parents on their annual school report. Should any child **not** meet the required standard set by the Government, then additional help and support will be given to those individuals and they will be given a further opportunity to be screened at the end of Year 2.

YEAR 4 MULTIPLICATIONS CHECK

The statutory DFE Multiplication check for all Year 4 pupils will take place on the 11th June 2025. This is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question.

Pupils in Year 4 are already familiar with the check and have been able to practise using similar formats regularly. Additional support will be provided for any pupil who may require this.

We will share your child's score with you, in their end of year report. There is no pass mark for the check but it will allow school to identify any additional support which maybe required as pupils move into Year 5 and Year 6.

All pupils achievements will be reported to parents at the end of the academic year. The end of year reports will be emailed on 11th July, with an oppportunity for a telephone appointment to be made, should you wish to discuss further with class teachers.

POLITE REMINDERS:

Snacks

We actively encourage fresh fruit snacks to be brought for any snacks needed at breaktime.

Hair

All long hair needs to be tied back due to health and safety reasons. Hair should be smart and appropriate for school and should be of a natural colour. Hairstyles, which are deemed to be extreme by the school, are not permitted. There must be no patterns/tramlines or extreme height. As guidance, hair should be no shorter than 2 on the sides.

Jewellery

For safety reasons, jewellery is not allowed in school, with the exception of watches. Watches should be removed for physical education and games. (Fitbits/activity trackers, smart watches or other similar devices are not permitted in school) Earrings (including studs) are not allowed in school

Pupils who come to school wearing earrings WILL be asked to remove them, plasters or invisible studs are <u>not acceptable</u> to cover newly pierced ears
