## Orangutans face extinction

### Introduction

For millennia, the orangutan has had the freedom of the forest; without any threat. Orangutans only live in the dense rainforests of Borneo and Sumatra. Numbers are dwindling detrimentally, and now there are well below 100,000 orangutans in the wild. This red ape has many names: Pongo (the scientific name) and 'person of the forest' - 'orang' meaning 'person', and 'utan' meaning 'forest'.

### Appearance
