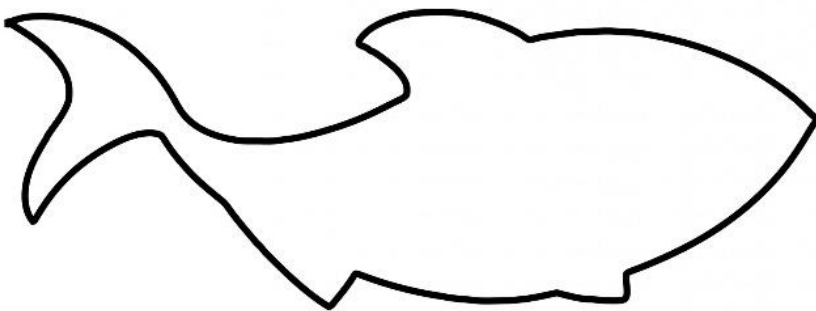
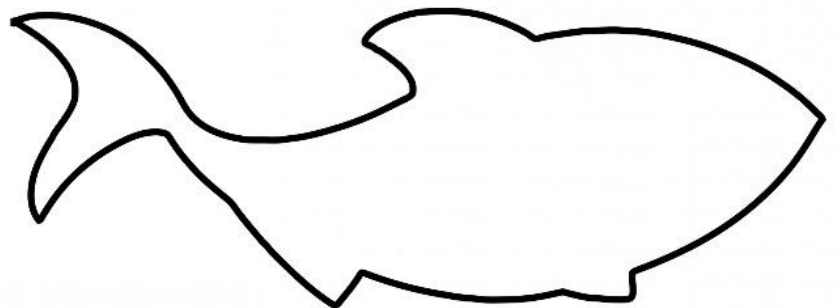
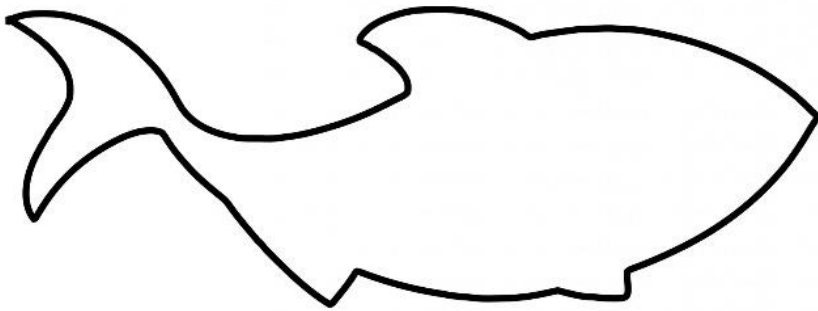

1) Draw your favourite possessions, and things that are most important to you in the fish below.



The First Disciples - Matthew 4:18-22

As Jesus walked along the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers. Their names were Peter and Andrew. They were fishermen. Together, they cast a net into the sea.

Jesus said to them, "Come with me, and I will make you fishers of people." At once, they left their net and followed Jesus.
