
Use these blank faces to experiment with different ways of using facial features to make facial expressions.



**There are lots of different ways you can use facial features to create different facial expressions...**

**MOUTHS:** Changing the shape of the mouth is one of these easiest ways to change a facial expression.

You could try using laughter lines in different places around the eyes when someone is smiling.



**EYEBROWS:**

Experiment with changing the position and angle of the eyebrows. How many different kinds of expressions can you create?

Try placing the eyeballs in different positions within the eyes.



**EYELIDS:**

Showing the eyelids both on the top and bottom can help to show what someone is feeling. How does the position of these eyelids change the facial expression?
