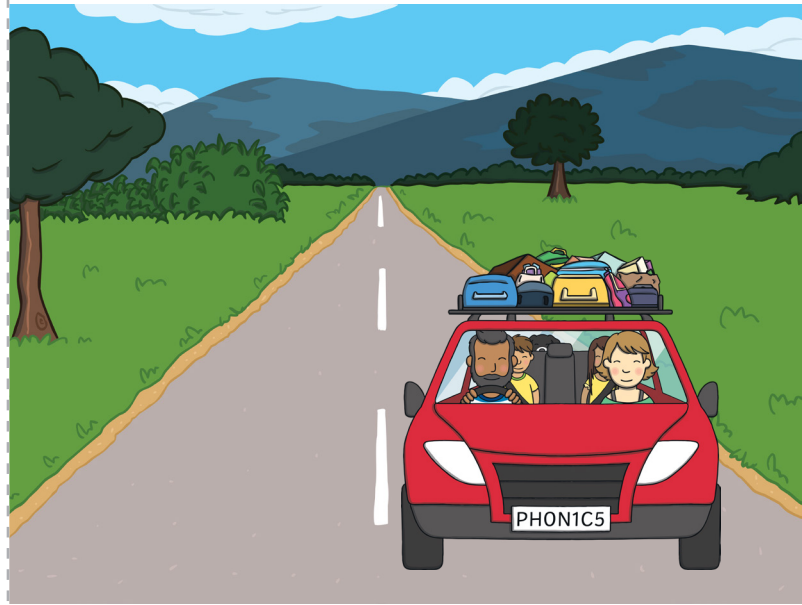




We stepped onto the stones and posed for a photo. Ben had his own fun later on by swimming in the sea and getting us all a bit wet!

Exploring Northern Ireland



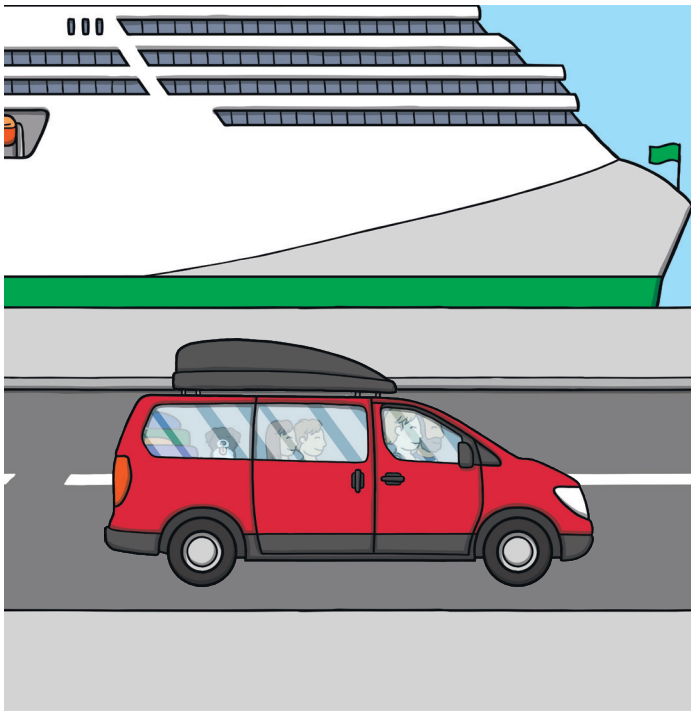
A 'Let's Read Together!' Book

Q5: What did the Scottish giant do when he saw Finn McCool?



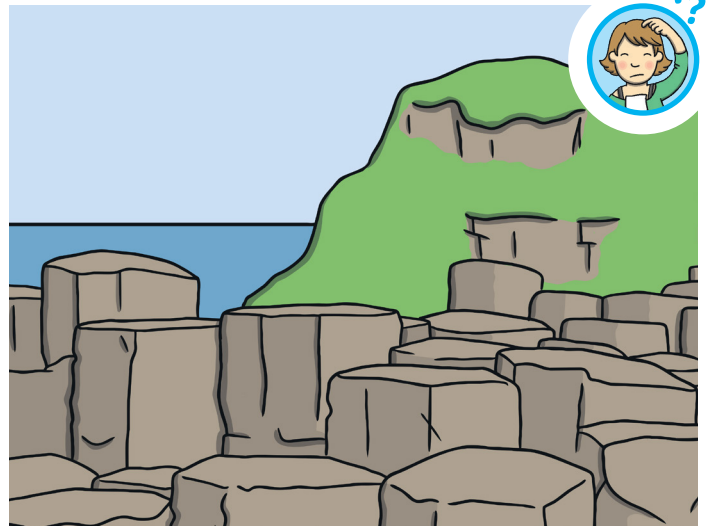
