LC: Can I create a simple branching database of my own choice?

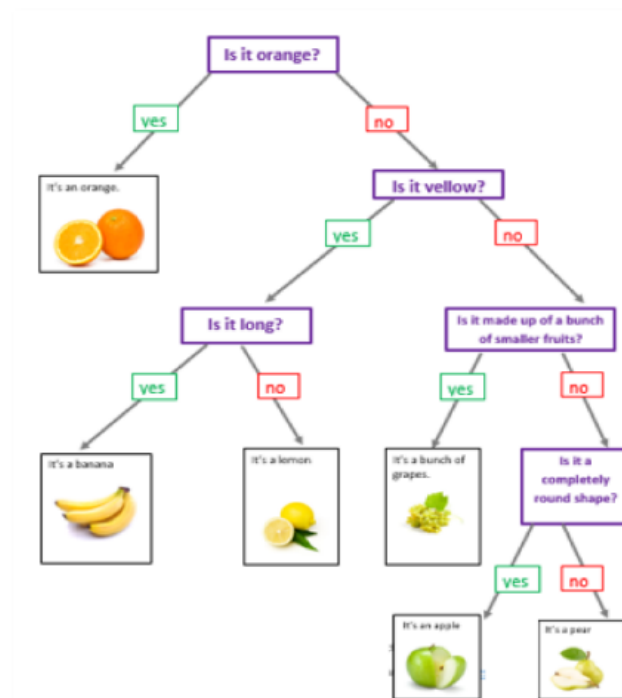
This week, you will make a branching database about a topic of your own choice. This has been set as a **2Do**  in Purple Mash. You will need to have completed last week's lesson, and understand how a branching database works, before you complete today's activity and create your own branching database. In today's lesson you will learn how to:

- Choose a suitable topic for a
- branching database.
- Select appropriate images.
- Create your own branching database.
- Use your own and others branching databases.

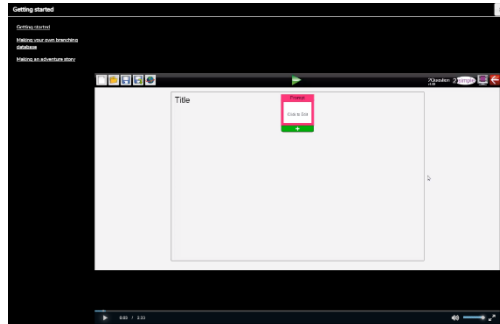

Here is a reminder of what a branching database looks like



Remember, you need to start with a question that will split the item into two groups. Continue doing this until the branching database is complete.
