King Ethelred  <p>Ethelred fled abroad to Spain when King Sven of Denmark and his son Cnut sailed up the River Humber to claim the throne. He returned to rule England again when King Sven died in AD 1014.</p>	King Sven  <p>King Sven of Denmark sailed up the rivers Humber and Trent to claim the throne in Danelow in AD 1013.</p>	King Cnut  <p>He is the son of King Sven. He became King of the Danes and King of England in AD 1016 after the death of Edmund Ironside.</p>	King Harold Harefoot  <p>He is the son of King Cnut and brother of King Hardicanute. When King Cnut died in AD 1035, Harold Harefoot and his brother, Hardicanute, shared the ruling of England.</p>	King Hardicanute  <p>He is the son of King Cnut and brother of King Harold. When his brother, Harold Harefoot, died in AD 1014, Hardicanute became the sole ruler of England.</p>	Edward the Confessor  <p>In AD 1042, Edward III the Confessor became King of England after he was invited to return to Britain from exile in Normandy. He is known as the 'Confessor' because he led a very religious life.</p>	Harold II  <p>Harold became King after the death of Edward the Confessor in 1066. Harold was shot through the eye during the Battle of Hastings.</p>
