### **GEOGRAPHY-**

### **SCIENCE**

#### What shall I wear today ?

- Observe changes across the four seasons.
- Ask and answer simple questions.
- Record findings using pictures, labels and captions.
- Perform a simple test.
- Describe weather associated with the seasons.
- Observe how day length varies.



#### What is growing in our garden ?

- identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees

### **LITERACY**

- Read and write poems with patterns, rhyme.
- Read and write information texts- weather.
- Punctuation- capitals, full stops, spaces, question mark, exclamation mark.
- Grammar- joining clauses using and, but.
- Adjectives to describe.

### **NUMERACY**

- Addition and subtraction within 20.
- Measurement- weight, volume

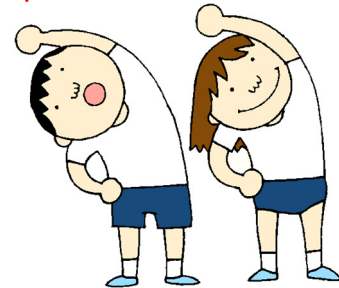
- Place value to 50.
